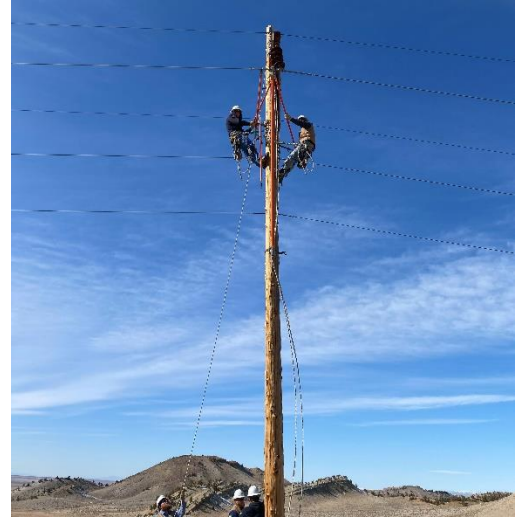

In July of 2022, Brian changed roles to Safety and Risk Manager for High Plains Power. In this position, he trains apprentices and manages the safety program, public safety, and education.
